

Using an AOL Mail Server for SMS Texting with Verizon Vtext.

Verizon "Vtext.com" is not working properly when sending SMS Text Messages through the Google Gmail SMTP Server. Vtext messages can take hours or even days to be received from Verizon. Verizon claims that Gmail is getting too much spam. A simple fix for us is to change from sending Text messages to sending Email messages. Instead of sending to "yourphonenumber@Gmail.com", send to "youremailaddress@Gmail.com". (Or other email app you may have on your phone AOL, Yahoo, Hotmail, etc.)

Otherwise to continue using "Vtext.com" use the AOL Mail Server instead of the Gmail Server. AOL requires you to use an "App Password" instead of your regular AOL Email Password, but it's very easy to create an AOL App Password.

First you have to create a Free AOL email account. AOL allows 500 free messages per day. Just go to AOL.com. Here is a youtube video on creating an AOL Email Account:

You will use the App Password instead of your AOL Login Password in RaceLog Pro SMS Setup Screen as seen below:
